

### **Impact1Hundred Awards \$18,000 in 2010**

Impact1Hundred membership more than doubled this year – growing from 7 members to 18 making \$18,000.00 available! Also growing were the number of grant requests received from Community Services' programs. Three of these programs were voted to share this year's award.

Congratulations to Emergency Assistance – awarded \$6,300.00. The funds will be used to purchase eye exams/glasses for visually impaired individuals (low-income, uninsured and underinsured). Also non-prescriptive items that are required in addition to prescriptions.

Congratulations to Outpatient Counseling – awarded \$10,000.00. Funds will be used to purchase materials needed for the agency's testing library, including intelligence, achievement, personality and behavioral tests. All of these will be essential in the diagnosis and treatment planning – especially of complex cases. Obtaining a correct diagnosis early in treatment can lead to the decreased duration of treatment while increasing the success.

Congratulations to Quality Assurance – awarded \$1,700.00. Laptops will be purchased to be used in daily operations that include data analysis and performance monitoring for all agency programs. The work done by the Quality Assurance department is crucial for programs to maintain their funding and for the agency to maintain licensure and accreditation.
